Plantation Drive

The walk was organised by the Chandigarh Tree Lovers (CTL), a city based of environmentalists and botanists.

Dressed in their best the students explored their campus and discovered 35 species that grow there – from the ubiquitous north Indian varieties such as Sita Ashok, Amaltas, Ficus Decora, Baheda or Bibhtaki, Mango, Amla, Kusum, Teak, Shahtut, Jamun, Kikkar and Plumeria alba to the exotic Jackfruit, bottle palm, trumpet bushes and Bismarckia Palm. They were guided by a team of tree experts, led by founder member of the group retired IFS(Indian Forest Services) from Himachal Pradesh, Harsh Mitter.

The experts taught the students different ways to distinguish similar looking trees by examining their roots, leaves and structure. They were also primed about the benefits of each tree species. The students were also introduced to the most common trees found of Chandigarh, Mohali and Panchkula.


