### Compliance Report

- Institute Innovation Council (IIC) set up on October 17<sup>th</sup> 2023. Incharge and members were identified and allocated duties. A three-day Entrepreneurship Development Programme was organized from February 15-17, 2024, by the Institution's Innovation Cell (IIC) in collaboration with the Regional Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (RCED). The programme was inaugurated by Dr Abha Sudarshan, the college principal. A total of 79 students from various streams participated in the programme, where they received information on the importance of selfemployment, skills required for entrepreneurship, and government support available for new ventures. In collaboration with the Institution's Innovation Council, National Youth Day was celebrated on January 12, 2024. In collaboration with the Department of Environment Studies, the Innovation Council celebrated National Pollution Control Day on December 02, 2023. An Inter-college Virtual Quiz was conducted to raise awareness and test students' knowledge on pollution control policies and methods in the country.
- An official Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been established between the college and Bharat Soka Gakkai, a non-governmental organization dedicated to promoting awareness of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. The primary focus of this partnership is the establishment of an SDG Club within the institution. The MoU is effective for duration of three years, commencing on February 02, 2024, and concluding on February 02, 2027.
- MOU signed with Board of Apprenticeship and Training Govt. of India on October 16<sup>th</sup> 2023.
- MOU signed with Panchkula based society HELP for providing help to poor and needy students on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2023.
- Under the RUSA Infrastructure grant for the renovation and upgradation of the college campus, Multimedia Hall (after renovation and upgradation) was completed on February 27, 2024. Currently, the renovation and upgradation of the Seminar Room is in progress. Administrative approval and rough cost estimates have also been obtained for the renovation and upgradation of the following areas: Examination Branch, Fine Arts Labs, Canteen Kitchen, Psychology Lab, Environment Conservation Lab, Defence Studies Lab, Functional English Lab, and Yoga Hall.

## Compliance Report

- Routine Departmental meetings were held throughout the session to discuss Remedial teaching to address the Advance and Slow Learners. Remedial teaching in college aims to provide additional support to students who need extra help with academic subjects. It often involves personalized instruction, smaller class sizes, and targeted interventions to address specific learning gaps. Advanced learners often grasp concepts quickly and may require more challenging material to stay engaged whereas slow learners may need extra time, personalized attention, and alternative teaching strategies to fully understand concepts. Providing differentiated instruction and ongoing support can help both advanced and slow learners thrive academically.
- Since NEP is to be implemented from next session, a talk was organised to orient faculty with NEP 2020 on 17th February 2024. Prospectus preparation committee was instructed to incorporate the changes in the upcoming prospectus so that information could be shared for the new admission seekers.
- A Tree Adoption Drive was initiated to develop a sense of responsibility amongst students for nurturing green cover in and around the campus. Fruit-bearing tree corner featured prominently at the Tree Adoption Drive.
- Reconstitution of IQAC according to NAAC guidelines will be implemented in the next session, 2024-25.
