## **ADMINISTRATION**

The process of administering a large institution has to be worked by clear direction, proper execution of what is required to be done along with the fair play in the exercise of the powers and duties. Our College as an institution stands out markedly in this regard.

The College has enrolled 1897 students out of which 600 are girls and 1297 are boys. There are 65 Staff members out of which 45 regular and 20 are contractual faculty members, all of whom are highly qualified and dedicated. Two of our Associate Professors Prof. (Dr.) J.K. Sehgal and Prof. (Dr.) Sneh Sharma got promoted as Professors in Commerce and Hindi Department respectively. The total number of sanctioned teaching staff is



64 and non-teaching is 49. The library staff comprises of 9 members-2 librarians; 4 restorers and 3 attendants. Dr. Yashpal Kaur is the Dean and Prof. (Dr.) J.K. Sehgal is the Vice-Principal of the College. Dr. Harjinder Singh, the Bursar provides the necessary guidance in the management of College funds. Mr. A.S. Negi and Ms. Satnam Kaur are the Superintendents of the College. The College functions as a team of conscientious workers cohesively.

**EXAMINATIONS and ACADEMICS:** Dr. Prem Sagar, Mrs. Anita Beri and their team worked hard to ensure the smooth conduct of the House Examinations and marking of internal assessment in accordance with Panjab University norms. I take pride in announcing that our students fared very well in 2014.

The College library caters both to intellectual as well as the general reading needs of its reader in an ideal and reader friendly environment. The College library has at present a good collection of more than 39691 books upto Jan.'15. It is subscribing about 33 Journals, 50 magazines and 17 Newspapers.
