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INSTITUTIONAL PROFILE

AN OVERVIEW

Nestled in the south of the City Beautiful, Post Graduate Government College, Sector-46, Chandigarh is a leading multidisciplinary institution of higher learning. Though it is just over four decades old, it has made rapid strides in academic excellence, both qualitatively and quantitatively. Evaluated by NAAC for Cycle-II accreditation with a Grade ‘A’ and a CGPA Score of 3.04, in September 2015, it is an institute that prepares students to succeed as educators, leaders and engaged citizens in an increasingly complex and diverse society.

BRIEF HISTORY

The college was established by the government through affiliation with Panjab University as a College for boys and became functional on July 13, 1982. At the outset, it was housed in a building of the Government School, Sector-40, Chandigarh and was moved to its present spacious and sprawling new 16.02-acre eco-friendly campus in 1989. The foundation stone of the building was laid by the then Governor, Sh. S.S. Ray and the college morphed into a co-educational institute in the year 1992. At first, the College offered basic courses in BA (Humanities) and BCom. However, it added new courses and streams over the years and leapt ahead with noticeable achievements. A UGC-sponsored vocational course in Advertising and Sales Promotion was added in 1997 followed by BBA in 2017; BCA and MCom in 1999 and 2000 respectively. Adding new dimensions to the college profile, environment conservation was added as an undergraduate course of study in 2019.

ADMINISTRATION



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The process of administering a large institution works through clear direction, proper execution of what is required to be done and fair play in the exercise of the powers and responsibilities. The college as an institution stands out markedly in this regard. The college has enrolled 2173 students of which 766 are girls and 1407 are boys. There are 57 teaching staff members out of which 30 are regular and 27 are on contract, all of whom are highly qualified and dedicated. The total number of sanctioned posts of teaching staff is 64 (including the principal) and that of non-teaching is 49. The library staff comprises 07 members (01 librarian, 03 restorers and 03 attendants). Dr Rajesh Kumar is the Dean, Dr Baljit Singh is the Vice-Principal and Dr Surinder Kaur is the Bursar of the college. Ms Paramjeet Kaur is the Superintendent of the college.

COURSES OFFERED

In its untiring quest for excellence in education, the college has been working to achieve its objectives as enshrined in its vision and mission. For us, each student is unique and has the potential to excel in scores in special ways. The college offers undergraduate programmes in various disciplines such as Humanities (the students are offered a choice of 25 subjects in general and 10 subjects in the Honours course), Commerce, Business Administration and Computer Applications. The college also offers a Postgraduate course in Commerce that serves as a platform to study principles of accounting, money & banking systems and economic theory; it provides knowledge about business, micro & macroeconomics, etc. and is also suitable for students who want to go for higher studies or do research work in the area of statistics & other related areas. Thus, all the courses of study offered here, have been framed to give full attention to alternative possibilities and comprehensive intellectual discourse to its students on campus.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college library supports the educational mission of the college with an unrelenting commitment to excellence. It acts as a locus of intellectual activity supporting the teaching, research and learning needs. The library has been set up on a modernized platform. It caters to the intellectual as well as the general reading needs of its readers in an ideal and reader-friendly environment with the provision of an open-access system.



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INSIDE THE LIBRARY

The library offers space for reading, curiosity and research; space for collaboration and learning. The audio-visual section of the library displays current information on various aspects related to health, career, religion, amazing facts, stress-free examination, etc. and other ephemera for effective and efficient utilization. Furthermore, a clipping file is maintained in the library in which news clippings related to the college are gathered from a variety of local newspapers.

LIBRARY COLLECTION

The library continues to evolve, grow, and adapt to the changing needs of its users with a special focus on supplying individualized assistance on a one-to-one basis to a diverse clientele of students and faculty in their quest for the acquisition and integration of knowledge. The college library boasts a collection of 48339 books, including textbooks, general books, reference books, and a book bank; access to e-resources, including more e-journals and e-books) under the N-LIST programme; 24 journals; 24 magazines and 9 newspapers.

- acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.
- develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and
- practise national integration and social harmony.

NSS MOTTO: The ideological orientation of the NSS is inspired by the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi. Very appropriately, the motto of NSS is “NOT ME, BUT YOU”. The college has four NSS units. The program officers of the NSS are Dr Amanpreet Kaur, Ms Pooja Gupta and Dr Arvinder Singh. Our NSS volunteers contributed their services to all the events organized in the college and worked ceaselessly for the community. The details of the activities carried out throughout the session are as follows:



One-Day Camp: NSS volunteers of the college carried out a cleanliness drive in the college campus during its first one-day camp of the session on July 29, 2023. The primary focus of this partnership is the establishment of an SDG Club within the institution. The MoU is effective for duration of three years, commencing on February 02, 2024, and concluding on February 02, 2027. During this period, the agreement will support the activities of the Sustainable Development Goals Club in the following ways:
 - Organizing training/orientation for the SDG Club members to conduct activities of the Club.
 - Suggesting the agenda/content of the meetings of the Club.
 - Providing materials/resources on SDGs - such as short films/essays etc.



- Inviting guests for seminars, guest lectures and workshops from time to time.
 - Discussing and formulating new ideas with the college to further the SDG initiatives the college.
- A Memorandum of Understanding was signed with a society based in Panchkula to provide assistance to underprivileged students. The Secretary of the society, Mr. Arvinder Berry, signed the MoU on October 26, 2023.
- A Memorandum of Understanding was signed with the Board of Apprenticeship and Training, Government of India on October 16, 2023.
