



#### 1. How well you actively participate in the class discussion, class assignments and activities




69.3 % students agreed to the statement that they actively participated in the class discussion, class assignments and activities. However, very few students disagreed with it and 26.6% were neutral about it.

# 2. Do you think that college provides you adequate facilities to enhance your academic performance





# 3. Do you think college provides you adequate time management skills and helps you inculcates study habits





#### 4. Do you revise the lectures which are taught in your class




71.3% students agreed that they do revise the lectures which are taught in their class, to which very minimal 7.6% disagreed and 21.1% were neutral about it.

#### 5. Do you maintain a balance between extracurricular activities and your studies




63.5% students have agreed that they maintain a balance between extra-curricular activities and their studies, while 13.3% of them disagreed and 23.1% were neutral about it.

#### 6. How do you find the ambience of the college




44.7% students find the ambience of the college excellent while others felt the need for its improvement.





#### 1. Are you facilitated with ICT tools like laptops, LCD, Projectors, Smart boards etc.





#### 2. Does the college staff put extra efforts for students with learning disabilities




88.3% teachers felt that college staff puts extra efforts for students with learning disabilities, while 1.7 % did not agree to it and 10% were neutral about it.

#### 3. How often you have the freedom to try innovative methods for better Learning




81.7% Teachers felt that they have the freedom to try innovative methods for better Learning, while 1.6 % did not agree with the statement and 16.7% were neutral about it.

#### 4. Do you provide individual attention to each student in class




95% teachers felt that they provide individual attention to each student in class while 5% were neutral about it.

### 5. Do you find the college library facilities efficient enough




75% teachers found the college library facilities efficient enough for students and staff, while 1.7% did not agreed to it and 23.3% were neutral about it.





## Q 1. Do you think the college provided you adequate facilities to enhance your academic performance




83.6% Alumnus think that the college provided the adequate facilities to enhance their academic performance, while 7.6% did not agree with it and 8.8% were neutral about it.

# Q 2. Do you think college provided you with adequate time management skills and did help you to inculcate it





#### Q 3. Does college taught you to maintain the work life balance in your day-to-day life




70.4% Alumnus think that the college taught them maintaining balance between work life and their day-to-day life, while 11.9% did not agree to it and 17.6% were neutral about it.

# Q 4. Do you think active participation in all the activities improved your academic performance




81.1% Alumnus think that their active participation in all the activities improved their academic performance, while 6.3% did not agree to it and 12.6% were neutral about it.

#### Q 5. Were you satisfied with the college canteen with respect to quality, price and hygiene?






