INSTITUTIONAL PROFILE

AN OVERVIEW

Strategically situated in the southern region of the City Beautiful, Post Graduate Government College-46 stands as a distinguished multidisciplinary institution of higher learning. Established over four decades ago, the college has rapidly advanced in both academic quality and quantity. In May 2024, it underwent evaluation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for its Cycle-III accreditation, securing a Grade 'B+' with a CGPA of 2.72.

A BRIEF HISTORY

Post Graduate Government College-46 was established by the government in affiliation with Panjab University as a boys' college and officially commenced operations on July 13, 1982. Initially located in the building of Government School, Sector-40, Chandigarh, the institution moved to its current expansive 16.02-acre eco-friendly campus in 1989. The foundation stone for the new building was laid by the then Governor, Sh. S.S. Ray. In 1992, the college transitioned to a coeducational institution.

Initially offering undergraduate programs in B.A (Humanities) and B.Com, the college progressively expanded its academic offerings. Notable developments include the introduction of a UGC-sponsored vocational course in Advertising and Sales Promotion in 1997, followed by the establishment of BBA in 2017, BCA in 1999, and M.Com in 2000. In 2019, the college further diversified its curriculum by introducing an undergraduate program in Environment Conservation, thereby enhancing its academic profile and contributing to the broader field of environmental studies.

This multi-faculty institution aims to provide inclusive education that fosters human values, professionalism, and scientific temper while establishing a community of scholars dedicated to the acquisition, creation, and dissemination of knowledge. ADMINISTRATION

Effective management is the cornerstone of any successful educational institution, relying on clear leadership, efficient execution of responsibilities, and equitable distribution of powers. In this regard, the college stands out as an exemplary model of academic administration and organizational efficiency. The leadership team is composed of:

The teaching faculty comprises 60 members, including 34 regular and 26 contractual staff, all of whom are highly qualified and committed to academic excellence. The total number of sanctioned teaching posts is 64, inclusive of the position of the Principal. Additionally, there are 49 sanctioned non-teaching positions, ensuring the smooth administrative and operational functioning of the institution. The college library is supported by a dedicated staff of 9 members, which includes 2 librarians (one regular and one on contract), 3 restorers, 3 attendants, and 1 peon.

Together, they provide visionary leadership and uphold the institution's commitment to academic integrity and student welfare.

COURSES OFFERED

In its untiring quest for excellence in education, the college has been working to achieve its objectives as enshrined in its vision and mission. For us, each student is unique and has the potential to excel in scores in remarkable ways. The college offers undergraduate programmes in various disciplines such as Humanities (the students are offered a choice of 25 subjects in general and 10 subjects in the Honours course), Commerce, Business Administration, and Computer Applications. The college also offers a Postgraduate course in Commerce that serves as a platform to study principles of accounting, money & banking systems, and economic theory; it provides knowledge about business, micro & macroeconomics, etc. and is also suitable for students who want to go for higher studies or do research work in statistics & other related areas. Thus, all the courses of study offered here, have been framed to give full attention to alternative possibilities and comprehensive intellectual discourse to its students on campus.

Bringing significant changes to the undergraduate programs, focusing on multidisciplinary learning and skill development, the college adopted the National Education Policy (NEP)2020 as introduced by Panjab University, Chandigarh.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The institution's advanced infrastructure supports a dynamic learning environment, equipped with modern facilities that enhance both teaching and student engagement. Our classrooms are aesthetically designed to inculcate a sense of discipline and induce high-quality learning. There are 21 general classrooms with ergonomic furniture, efficient lighting, and ventilation systems. 11 classrooms are equipped with smart interactive whiteboards, overhead projectors, and digital podiums and there is LAN connectivity in all the classrooms. With technological support, our skilled teachers provide guidance to each individual. The emphasis is on making every classroom session engaging plus interactive and thus the classrooms are designed to be compact. The institution features 13 laboratories to enhance students' practical skills and knowledge, complementing their theoretical studies, while sports facilities, including indoor/outdoor gyms, basketball and badminton courts, and a playground, promote physical activity, and accessibility to all floors is ensured through ramps, broad staircases, and corridors.

Additionally, the construction of the IT Block was completed in 2024. The four-storeyed block with an area of 5984 sq. feet is equipped with 02 computer labs, 04 lecture theatres, 01 soundproof audio room, 01 skill lab, and 06 classrooms with a lift facility and fully air-conditioned.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

The College Library plays a pivotal role in supporting the institution's educational mission, driven by an unwavering commitment to academic excellence. Serving as a vibrant hub of intellectual engagement, the library caters to the diverse teaching, research, and learning needs of students and faculty alike. Designed on a modernized platform, it offers a well-curated collection and facilities that promote both academic inquiry and general reading interests. Housed in a spacious, independent block spanning 926.97 square meters, the library provides a welcoming and reader-friendly environment enhanced by an open-access system, allowing users to freely explore the collection. On average, approximately 250 readers utilize the library's resources and services daily, reflecting its central role in the academic life of the college.

Inside the Library:

The library offers space for reading and research; and space for collaboration and learning. The audio-visual section of the library displays current information on various aspects related to health, career, religion, stress-free examination, etc., and other material for effective and efficient utilization. Furthermore, a clipping file is maintained in the library in which news clippings related to the College are gathered from a variety of local newspapers.

Library Collection:

The library continues to evolve, grow, and adapt to the changing needs of its users with a special focus on supplying individualized assistance on a one-to-one basis to a diverse clientele of students and faculty in their quest for the acquisition and integration of knowledge. The college library boasts a collection of 48953 books, including textbooks, general books, reference books, and a book bank; access to e-resources, including more e-journals and e-books) under the N-LIST programme; 24 journals; 33 magazines and 12 newspapers.

HOSTEL

The construction of new hostel blocks for both boys and girls is currently in progress, with completion targeted for the beginning of the 2025–26 academic session. These upcoming residential facilities are being developed with a focus on providing students with a safe, comfortable, and modern living environment. The hostels will be equipped with contemporary amenities such as well-furnished rooms, hygienic dining areas, dedicated study spaces, recreational zones, high-speed internet connectivity, and round-the-clock security. This initiative reflects the institution's commitment to enhancing student welfare and creating a holistic campus experience that supports both academic and personal growth.

ACTIVITIES OF THE UNITS/CLUBS/SOCIETIES

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The College has four NSS units. The programme officers of the NSS are Dr Amanpreet Kaur, Ms Pooja Gupta and Dr. Kulwinder Singh. The NSS volunteers contributed their services to all the events organized in the college and worked ceaselessly for the community.

- Van Mahotsav Celebrations under the campaign “Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam” were organised on July 07, 2024. Saplings of Litchi, Gulmohar, Amla, Jamun, and Mango were planted. The Plants were provided by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, UT Chandigarh.
- "Har Ghar Tiranga" Campaign was organised to celebrate the 78th Independence Day of India. A series of events like Patriotic Song Competition: A melodious tribute by students to the nation and its heroes, Poster Making Competition: Highlighted the significance of the national flag, Cultural Program: Included patriotic songs, speeches, and poems celebrating India's heritage and freedom struggle. Rally & Tableau: Students displayed posters, slogans, and banners were organised on August 09, 2024.
- To commemorate Partition Horrors Remembrance Day on August 14, 2024, a documentary titled “*Pain of the Partition*” was screened on campus. The film vividly portrayed the trauma, displacement, and human suffering endured during the Partition of India. The screening was followed by a reflective discussion, where students and faculty shared thoughts on the historical impact and relevance of the event in today's context. The initiative aimed to foster empathy, historical awareness, and a deeper understanding of the importance of peace and unity.
- An Orientation Programme cum Poshan Maah Campaign was organized on September 09, 2024, to welcome new students and promote awareness about health and nutrition. The event featured a keynote address by Dr. Nemi Chand (State Liaison Officer, NSS, UT), who spoke on the NSS ideology “Community Before Self” and emphasized the vital role of youth in nation-building and social service. As part of the Poshan Maah initiative, a Health Awareness Session was conducted by Dr. Ramneek and her team from Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.

The session focused on anaemia—its causes, effects, and prevention—and aimed to educate students about maintaining good health through balanced nutrition and early detection.

- To mark World Mental Health Day on October 10, 2024, the college NSS unit organized a Stress Management Workshop aimed at promoting mental well-being among students and staff. The session was led by Dr. Nidhi Jaswal, a seasoned clinical psychologist with 18 years of experience. Through an engaging and interactive session, Dr. Jaswal shared practical strategies to help young individuals manage stress and lead healthier, more balanced lives. As part of the event, two significant publications were launched:

- “Unwind: Stress Busting Guide for Young Minds”, a practical guidebook authored by Dr. Nidhi Jaswal, tailored to address the unique stressors faced by today’s youth.
- The college’s annual magazine, “Amaranth”, was also released under the editorial guidance of Dr. Ramandeep Kaur, Chief Editor, celebrating the creative and academic achievements of the student community.

Additionally, Dr. Beenu Varma, Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychology, delivered an insightful address on the 2024 theme “Mental Health at the Workplace.” Her talk emphasized the importance of mental health support systems within professional settings and encouraged participants to prioritize well-being in their future careers. The event fostered greater awareness and open dialogue around mental health, underlining the college’s commitment to holistic education and emotional wellness.

- The college observed Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) on October 30, 2024, to honour the legacy of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, India’s first Deputy Prime Minister and Home Minister, revered as the *"Iron Man of India"* for his pivotal role in unifying the nation. The event began with the National Unity Day Pledge, administered by Prof. J.K. Sehgal, Principal of the college. The pledge inspired students and faculty to uphold the values of unity, integrity, and patriotism. Following the pledge, Prof. Rajinder Singh Koura, Head of the Department of Physical Education, delivered an insightful address highlighting Sardar Patel’s monumental contribution to the integration of over 560 princely states into a united

India. The celebration served as a powerful reminder of the strength in unity and the importance of preserving national integrity.

- A Drug De-addiction Workshop was held on November 07, 2024, as part of the college's ongoing commitment to raising awareness about substance abuse and promoting healthy lifestyles among youth. The workshop featured a series of interactive sessions presented in an engaging and informative format. The event included PowerPoint presentations and expert talks that shed light on the dangers of drug abuse, its impact on individuals and families, and the importance of early intervention. A poem recitation on the theme of drug de-addiction added an emotional and artistic dimension to the programme, resonating deeply with the audience. Participants were also given practical tips on community support and collective responsibility in addressing drug-related issues. A highlight of the workshop was the screening of an award-winning documentary, which showcased real-life stories of addiction and recovery, offering both a stark warning and a message of hope.

In addition, NSS volunteers, under the guidance of NSS Program Officers, delivered creative presentations that reflected both awareness and thoughtful analysis of the issue, reinforcing the importance of student involvement in social causes.

- A Financial Literacy Program was organized on November 12, 2024, to educate students on essential aspects of personal finance and responsible money management in today's digital world. The event featured informative sessions by experts from the Reserve Bank of India and HDFC Bank, along with insights from the college's leadership. Mr. Manjit Kumar from the RBI opened the session with a comprehensive talk on the role of the Central Bank in currency management and foreign exchange, helping students understand the backbone of India's monetary system. Mr. Rishu Sharma from HDFC Bank followed with a session on government schemes and student-friendly banking products, encouraging students to actively engage with formal banking systems. Mr. Parminder Singh addressed the growing concern of cyber threats and digital banking crimes, equipping students with valuable tips on how to stay safe online. Mr. Saurav Sood delivered an engaging talk on the importance of saving and timely investments, highlighting practical strategies for long-term financial planning. The session was highly interactive and well-received,

empowering students with practical financial knowledge and reinforcing the importance of early financial literacy in shaping informed, responsible individuals.

- The NSS 7-Day Special Camp, held from January 3 to 15, 2025, was a vibrant and enriching experience designed to promote community engagement, personal development, and social responsibility among volunteers. Day 1 began with group formation and field activities including fitness sessions, a campus cleanliness drive, and painting tree trunks with lime water as part of an environmental initiative. Day 2 focused on yoga and holistic wellness, featuring a morning yoga session by Dr. Sunita and her team, followed by a laughter yoga segment conducted by Dr. Nidhi Jaswal from Ketawa Centre. Prof. (Dr.) Sneh Harshinder Sharma also addressed students on the value of cultural heritage and maintaining a healthy lifestyle. On Day 3, Mr. Sanjeev Gulati, State Mission Coordinator, Department of Social Welfare, Chandigarh Administration, introduced various government schemes aimed at building an inclusive society. Day 4 saw a visit to the adopted village, Ram Darbar, where NSS volunteers organized a Swachh Bharat awareness rally and performed a compelling *Nukkad Natak* (street play) to engage the local community. Day 5 focused on child protection and health awareness, with NGO Bachpan leading sessions on child abuse prevention, and Dr. Vishaw Gaurav conducting a dynamic health and fitness session. Day 6 emphasized digital and financial literacy through informative sessions by Dr. Sumit Gill and Dr. Vikram Khanna, who offered practical insights into cyber awareness and money management. The camp concluded on Day 7 with a grand closing ceremony. Dr. Nemi Chand, State Liaison Officer (NSS), Chandigarh, served as the keynote speaker.
- An Awareness Workshop was organized on February 11, 2025, in observance of Safer Internet Day, aiming to promote responsible and safe internet usage among students. The workshop featured informative sessions on the potential risks of the online world and practical strategies for protecting personal information.
